G.O.(P) No. 18/94/P&ARD. Dated, Thiruvananthapuram 5th April, 1994

S. R. O. No. 412/94.—In pursuance of clause (f) of Article 16 of the Constitution of India, the Government of Kerala hereby clarify that the terms 'Mappila' and 'Muslim' occurring in the schedule to G.O.(Ms) No. 141/78/GAD dated the 15th March, 1978, and published as S.R.O. No. 302/78 in Part I, Section iv of the Kerala Gazette No. 15 dated the 11th April, 1978 are synonymous so far as Kerala State is concerned.

Explanatory Note

(This does not form part of the notification, but is inserted to indicate its general purport).

The 'Muslims' in the erstwhile Malabar area are usually called as 'Mappilas'. But both the terms 'Mappila' and 'Muslim' occur in the State list of OBCs published as per G.O.(Ms) No. 141/78/GAD dated 15-3-1978. Actually both the communities are one and the same as far as this State is concerned and hence it is considered necessary to make this point clear. This notification is intended to achieve the above object.
